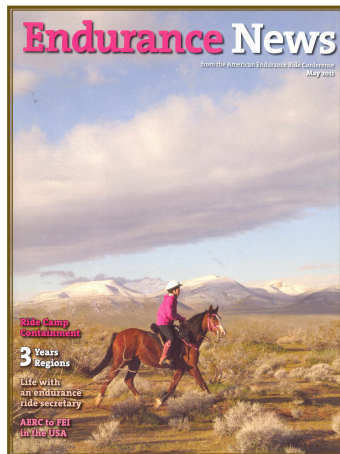

EHV-1 and EHM Situation Update

In the last couple of weeks the horse industry's eyes have been on the outbreak of EHV-1 and EHM that started in the U.S. in Ogden, Utah at the National Cutting Horse Association's Western Championship. Horses leaving this event started a spread of the disease across the western U.S. primarily. But initial fears that this could be an epidemic have proven unfounded. As can be seen from the detailed figures, state and federal officials are doing a wonderful job of containing the virus.

After discussions with a state veterinary official last week, I learned several things about the disease. First, even for very ill horses, most recover. Secondly, if the virus is passed on to other horses, it weakens as it stair steps down, as is the case with many disease outbreaks. But the good news, as is shown in the referenced report, it hasn't become an epidemic.

The USDA has praised state officials for acting quickly to contain exposed horses within their states and credits this effort, plus the awareness and vigilance of owners to monitor suspect horse's temperatures, for the fact that the number of effected horses has remained low. It's important to remember

that the low number of effected horses is out of an overall U.S. population of 9.2 million horses. It is also a fact that with only a few exceptions, this outbreak has been within one discipline.

In talking with management of our shows, all are being vigilant DD and many have shared policies and practices that have been put in place to insure horses attending events are screened and monitored throughout their events. One of the greatest tools, whether at an event or on your own farm, is to be alert for temperature spikes and isolate any horse with a rise in temperature. So while our industry is breathing easier, we should still be alert for any changes in our horses' condition. A temperature of 101.5 degrees or higher should trigger a call to your veterinarian.
