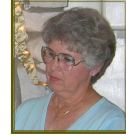

Resolution 8, Add Arabian Comparative Judging System to AHA Handbook

Resolution 1, Redefining Age Limit for Youth. With Modification. Very long so will not repeat it here. Full resolution can be found on AHA website: <http://www.arabianhorses.org>

Resolution 2, Resolution Submission Date: With Modification. That AHA Chapter 9, RULE 101.4 be amended to read: To the AHA office to be postmarked/electronic transaction dates (BOD 8/00) (Res. 7-93) not later than August 15th preceding the next Annual Convention. Changes to proposed resolutions shall be accepted no later than 7 days after the resolution submission deadline, except:

At the request of the Agenda and Resolutions Committee to comply with RULE 101. Submission requirements.

After the resolutions have been printed for mailing as an amendment to the resolution pursuant to the Standing Rules of the Convention and Roberts Rules of Order Newly Revised.

All resolutions will be made available for electronic download not later than 45 days preceding the next Annual Convention (Res. 4-08).

Printed copies, if requested, will be returned to the delegate(s) of the Member Organization, upon convention registration, not later than 45 days preceding the next Annual Convention (Res. 4-08); and, Be it Further Resolved, That the rest of AHA Rule 101.4 be re-lettered accordingly.

Resolution 5, Updating Level Judges: Resolved, USEF GR1004.16. be amended by inserting "Eastern and Western Canadian Breeders Championships" between East Coast Championships and National Shows.

Effective: December 31, 2012 or upon approval by USEF/EC.

Resolution 6, Ginger Testing: With Modification. Very long, can be found on above AHA website link.

Resolution 7, Bar Shoe: With modification. Resolved, That USEF AR103.2 be changed to read:

Any machine made shoe (keg), or handmade shoe made of magnetic steel, mild steel, aluminum, rubber or other non-metallic shoe is allowed. No part of the shoe may exceed the dimensions of 3/8 inch thick by 1 1/8 inches wide (nail heads and/or toe clips are not considered when measuring the shoe). Aluminum, rubber, or other non-metallic shoes are exempt from the dimension requirements. The shoe may be of any type and configuration, except in the case of a bar shoe there may be only one bar. A bar is part of the shoe and must not exceed the dimensions of 3/8" thick by 1 1/8" wide, nor may it extend below the ground surface of the shoe. If a shoe band is used, it may be attached to the shoe, or the pad if present. Effective: December 31, 2011 or when approved by USEF/EC

Resolution 9, Whip Length in Sport Horse Under Saddle: With modification. Resolved, That USEF AR159 Appointments, section 4.b be amended to read: Gloves of conservative color are optional for either style of attire. Spurs and whip are optional. If a whip is carried, it may not exceed the length requirements in DR120.; and, Be it Further

Resolved, That corresponding EC rules also be changed Effective: December 31, 2012 or upon approval by USEF/EC

Resolution 12, Hunter Seat Equitation Changes: That AHA Comp 809.9 Hunter Seat Not to Jump be amended by striking out and inserting:

In Hunter Seat Equitation Not to Jump, all riders are required to perform the pattern. Markers shall not be used as picking the spot is part of the class. Riders 14—17 shall perform two or more individual tests

from USEF Test 1, 4, 8, 9, 11, 15, 17, 19 or EC equivalent. (Res 30-97) Riders 13 and under shall perform two or more individual tests from USEF Test 1-4, 8 or EC equivalent, (Res. 30-97)

RESOLUTION # 14-11, Education/Evaluation Commission Term Limits: Resolved, That Resolution 5-90 be amended to read: f) The Commission will consist of 9 members, elected by the Board of Directors for 3-year rotating term. The commission is to consist of any member of AHA (34-98) who ideally would have relevant experience in the area of educational program development and/or delivery. No member may serve more than three consecutive terms; and, Be It Further

Resolved, That the term limits be added to CBP 124 of the AHA Handbook. Effective: December 31, 2012

RESOLUTION # 15-11, Refund of 9-90 Fee for a Vet-Out Horse: Resolved, That Resolution 9-90, paragraph 3, be amended by inserting "The 9-90 fee will be refunded to the exhibitor of a horse which is vetted out of a show before the show begins and is in compliance with the show's vet out policy." after competitions, and Be It Further

Resolved, That COMP 203.1.c, 401.4, 402.3, 403.3 has the following sentence included; The 9-90 fee from a vetted out horse will be refunded to the exhibitor by the competition. Effective December 31, 2012

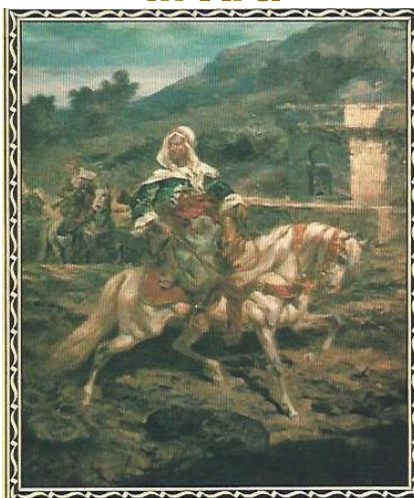

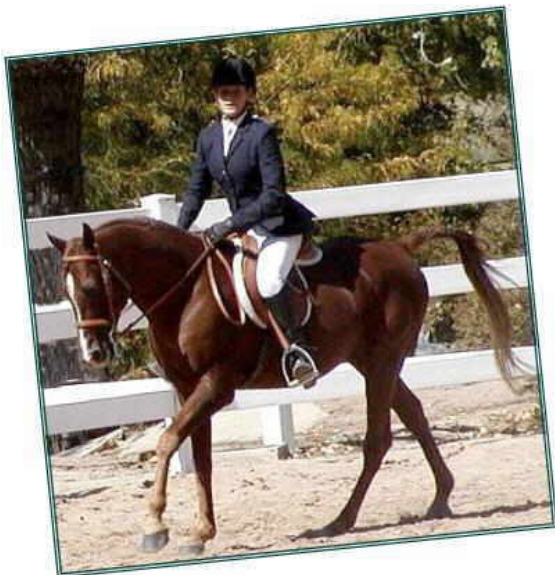
