## Bill Thornburgh Friends and Family Endurance Ride

The Bill Thornburgh Friends and Family Endurance Rides will take  
place October 29 and 30.  
*AERC and AHA Sanctioned*

- 30** miles flat trail with good footing on Oct 29 2011, starting at 08:00
- 50** miles flat trail with good footing on Oct 29 2011, starting at 07:00
- 25** miles flat trail with good footing on Oct 30 2011, starting at 08:00
- 50** miles flat trail with good footing on Oct 30 2011, starting at 07:00

The majority of the ride is on flat power line or jeep roads with good footing and very few rocks. Plenty of horse water and hay are provided at checkpoints along the trail. All vet checks are in the home base vet check area.

### General Info

Whether you are new to endurance riding or have many years of experience, this ride is intended to capture the spirit of "To Finish is To Win" and have a fun time doing it! The majority of the ride is on flat power line or jeep roads with good footing and very few rocks. Plenty of horse water and hay are provided at checkpoints along the trail. All vet checks are in the home base vet check area.

### Camping

Camping is available 1.5 blocks from vet check area. Please respect the camp area by not driving over bushes and natural desert shrubbery. **ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASHES** and no fires are permitted in the camping area. Horse water will be available in base camp. No riders are to arrive before Friday unless arrangements are made prior to arrival. The weather is variable so you should plan for wind, cold nights and warm days.

### Food

All riders will have a dinner meal ticket for the night of the ride included with entry. Additional dinners are available for \$12, and must be reserved in advance.

### Vetting & Ride Meeting

This is an AERC and AHA sanctioned ride. All AERC rules will apply to this event. Please see [www.aerc.org](http://www.aerc.org) for a complete list of AERC rules. Pre-ride vet check will be on Friday from 3:00 pm to 6:00 pm. Saturday morning pre-ride vet exams must be arranged in advance. The ride meeting will be held on Friday evening at in the home base vet check area. All Veterinary & Ride Management decisions are final. Please note that the vets may elect to opt for more stringent finish line pulse criteria than the minimum criteria allowed by AERC rules.

All competitors are totally responsible for self, crew and their equine before, during and after the ride. Entrants or their crews, who are in any way rude or insulting to vets, ride management, volunteers, or local landowners or tourists, will risk disqualification of their rider.

### Directions to Base Camp

**From 395 Southbound:** Approx. 2-3 miles south of Pearsonville, start looking for Brown Road turn off. Turn LEFT on Brown Road and follow it around a right hand curve. Turn RIGHT on Panorama Trail, which is a dirt road. Base camp will be on the left side about ½ mile up.

**From Hwy 14/Hwy 395 North:** Take the Hwy 178- Inyokern/Ridgecrest turn off. Go through town to Brown Road. Turn LEFT on Brown Road. Drive approximately 9 miles. Turn LEFT on Panorama Trail, which is a dirt road. Base camp will be on the left side about ½ mile up.

Each Episode will air three times on HRTV and then will be shown on [www.actha.tv](http://www.actha.tv). These are the current

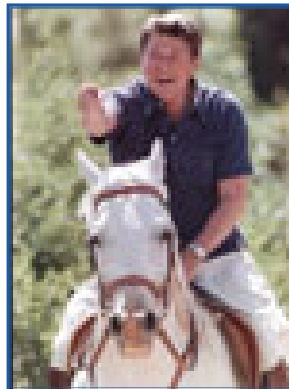
show times for HRTV:
